Education and Care Services National Regulations 2011, regulation 102, Authorisation for excursions, states that children can be taken on routine excursions if written consent for routine excursions has been obtained within the previous 12 months.

When we are on a routine outing a notice will be displayed on the door of the room (with the exception of walking to and from school) stating:

- That the children are on a routine outing
- The location of the outing
- The time the children are expected to return
